Teaching Orthodoxy...using Bible Verses:

Lesson 3: The Son and Holy Spirit are EQUAL to the Father.

All Three Divine Persons are **ONE in Essence (Nature)**

And All Three are **ONE by constant interpenetration (Undivided)**

God's Son is eternally EQUAL with the Father.

Jesus said: "And now, Father, glorify me in your presence with the glory I had with You before the world began." John 17:5

Now we know that the Son of God is come and has given us understanding, so that we may know Him who *is* **true**; and we are in Him who *is* **true**, in His Son Jesus Christ. **He is the true God and eternal life**. 1 John 5:20

If we **fail** to **honor** the Son as **<u>EQUAL</u>** to the Father, **then we lose** the Father too.

that <u>all may **honor the Son** just as they **honor the Father**</u>. Whoever does not honor the Son does not honor the Father, who sent Him. John 5:23

Whoever **<u>denies</u>** the Son **<u>does</u> not <u>have</u>** the Father; the one who confesses the Son has the Father also. 1 John 2:23

Whoever hates Me hates My Father as well. John 15:23

is a **Third Person: the Holy Spirit.** He is **EQUAL** to the Father and the Son.

Go ye therefore, and **teach** all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, **and of the Holy Spirit**: Matthew 28:19

But when the **Comforter** is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even **the Spirit** of truth, which **proceedeth from the Father**, He shall testify of me. John 15:26

Now the Lord is the Spirit. 2 Corinthians 3:17

Then Peter said, "Ananias you have lied to the <u>Holy Spirit</u>...You have not lied to men but to <u>God</u>." Acts 5:3-4

The Father and Son and Spirit are **one** in Divine **Essence** (i.e. Nature), but are **three** in Person. As we say: "The Trinity, **one in essence**, and undivided."

Jesus said: I and the Father are <u>one</u>. John 10:30

Jesus said: And he who sees Me sees Him Who sent Me. John 12:45

For <u>in Him</u> [*i.e. Christ*] <u>dwelleth</u> all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. Col. 2:9 [For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form. *NIV*]

The Father and Son and Spirit are also **one by interpenetration** (i.e. undivided because They always live inside each other). As we say: "...**and <u>undivided</u>**."

Jesus said: Believe Me when I say that I am <u>in</u> the Father and the Father is <u>in</u> Me. John 14:11

Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? <u>He who has **seen Me** has **seen the Father**; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?" Do you not believe that <u>I am in the Father, and the Father in Me</u>? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but <u>the Father Who dwells in Me</u> does the works. John 14:9-10</u>
