Teaching Orthodoxy...using Bible Verses: Lesson 4: The Holy Trinity is One in Essence and undivided, and shares one Divine Will. Faith is needed for Salvation.

The Father and Son and Spirit are **one** in Divine **Essence** (i.e. Nature), but are **three** in Person. As we say: "The Trinity, <u>one in essence</u>, and undivided."

Jesus said: I and the Father are **<u>one</u>**. John 10:30

Jesus said: And he who sees Me sees Him Who sent Me. John 12:45

For <u>in Him</u> [*i.e. Christ*] <u>dwelleth</u> all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. Col. 2:9 [For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form. *NIV*]

The Father and Son and Spirit are also **one by interpenetration** (i.e. undivided because They always live inside each other). As we say: "...and <u>undivided</u>."

Jesus said: Believe Me when I say that I am <u>in</u> the Father and the Father is <u>in</u> Me. John 14:11

Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? <u>He who has seen Me has seen the Father</u>; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?" Do you not believe that <u>I am in the Father, and the Father in Me</u>? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but <u>the Father Who dwells in Me</u> does the works. John 14:9-10

The Most Holy Trinity is **not** three gods, because They <u>share</u> the Father's <u>one</u> <u>Divine Will</u>. [IF there were three gods, each would have his own will...i.e. 3 gods = 3 different wills. They could disagree with each other and oppose each other. But with the Holy Trinity, the **three Divine Persons** <u>share One Will</u>, One Essence, One Power, One Life, One Kingdom, and are never separated, hence, a Three-in-One God.] Jesus said: <u>I can of mine own self do nothing</u>: as I hear, I judge: and My judgment is just; because I seek <u>not mine own will</u>, but <u>the will of the</u> <u>Father</u> which hath sent Me. John 5:30

For I did not speak on My own, but the Father Who sent Me commanded Me to say all that I have spoken. John 12:49

Then said Jesus unto them, "When ye have lifted up the Son of man, then shall ye know that **I am**, and that **I do nothing of Myself**; but as My Father hath taught Me, I speak these things." John 8:28

Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the **Son can do nothing by Himself**; He can <u>do only</u> what He sees His <u>Father doing</u>, because <u>whatever the Father does the Son also does</u>. For the Father loves the Son and <u>shows Him all He does</u>. Yes, and He will show Him even greater works than these, so that you will be amazed. For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, <u>even so the Son gives life</u> to whom He is pleased to give it. John 5:19-21

For I have come down from heaven not to do My will but <u>to do the will of</u> <u>Him who sent me</u>. John 6:38

We need to **believe in Jesus** in order to be saved and have everlasting life.

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that **whosoever** <u>believes</u> in Him should not perish, but have <u>everlasting life</u>. John 3:16

But these are written that you may **<u>believe</u>** that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by <u>believing you may have **life**</u> in His name. John 20:31

Therefore being justified **by faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Rom. 5:1

Eternal life is IN Jesus.

In Him was life; and the life was the light of men. John 1:4

Jesus is the **Lamb of God** Whom the Father gave to take away the sins of the world.

The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, "Behold, the <u>Lamb of</u> <u>God</u> Who takes away the sin of the world!" John 1:29
